Dear PG Families,

In light of public health guidelines issued by Gov. Gavin Newsom, Pleasant Grove Union School District, as well as all school districts in Sutter County will close all schools beginning Tuesday, March 17. Schools will remain closed at least through April 13.

Spring break is scheduled for April 6 through April 13. We will continue to monitor this situation very closely, and we will update our community and school families should there be an extension to the closure period following spring break.

This decision was not taken lightly. We have consulted carefully with local and state health officials throughout the past weeks. Yesterday's guidelines from Gov. Newsom related to limiting public activities made closure the appropriate action.

During the closure period, our district's school nutrition services department will continue to serve student meals. Details on where families can pick up meals for their school children will be sent later this week.

We also are working to provide optional academic learning opportunities to help students keep learning during this closure period. Specific information on these academic learning opportunities will be announced on our website and by email.
