PGJUSD is excited to provide the opportunity for our students to borrow a hotspot for internet connectivity for distance learning. Parents and students should carefully review the PGJUSD Responsible Use and Care Guidelines listed below.

Responsible Use and Care

- 1. The hotspot is to be treated as a valuable object. It should not be thrown, purposely dropped, or abused in any way.
- 3. The hotspot should not be used in or near proximity of water, household chemicals, or other liquids that could damage its electronic components.
- 4. The hotspot should be protected from the environment to prevent damage.

Parent/Guardian Responsibilities and Permission

I am authorizing the assignment of a hotspot to my family. I understand that it is to be used as a tool for learning and that my child will comply with the PGJUSD Responsible Use and Care Guidelines. I will help ensure the safe and timely return of the hotspot within the loan period. I also understand that I am financially responsible for any willful, malicious, or accidental damage. I understand the approximate replacement cost for a hotspot is \$375. I understand that my child may lose future loan privileges if it is either damaged or not returned in a timely manner.

Student Responsibilities and Permission

I agree to abide by the PGJUSD Technology User Agreement. I agree to take care of the hotspot while it is in my possession. I will not give the it to anyone else to use. I agree to return the hotspot and all components to the school in the same condition it was issued to me.

I acknowledge that the school has the right to monitor internet usage and content and may revoke the use of the hotspot based on unacceptable use.
