Dear PG Families,

I wanted to update everyone as we move forward with our school closure and distance / at home learning opportunities. Sutter County Superintendents met today via Zoom along with officials from Sutter County Health. We learned that we will receive an update to the “Stay at Home” orders from Department of Public Health this weekend. As we move forward with the phases of opening businesses and adjusting the orders there is no indication that schools can reopen this school year. With that said, **Pleasant Grove will extend our closure throughout the month of May and it is very doubtful that we can return until next school year.**

Teachers have worked extremely hard once again to create at home learning opportunities that are valuable, and your children can be successful with their completion. Staff also recognizes the difficulty families may be having as you continue to work and take on at home learning. We are all very appreciative of your efforts and commitment. As referenced in my last correspondence, **we will have a work packet drop off and pick up on Monday, May 4th between 9:00-12:00.** At this time, the packets and any completed work are due and the next three weeks will be provided.

Teachers will continue to make a weekly connection with students and/or families through a variety of methods, such as Zoom, emails, texts, or phone calls. Please note that as your children complete their studies, it is very important for you to communicate with the teachers any struggles families may be experiencing so teachers can work with families to ensure all of students are successful with at home learning. It will take a team effort with everyone involved, but most importantly for your children to participate and fully engage in their education and daily studies.

Continued daily time expectations for each grade level:

K=1hour 1st=1.5-2 hours 2nd=2 hours 3-5= 2.5-3 hours 6-8=2.5-3.5 hours

Pick up work packets for the next three weeks.
Pick up breakfast and lunch for the week.
- Monday, May 11th 11:00-12:00 Pick up breakfast and lunch for the week.
- Monday, May 18th 11:00-12:00 Pick up breakfast and lunch for the week.
- Tuesday, May 26th 9:00-12:00 Drop off May’s work packets
Return all school materials, library books laptops.
This final week is a “catch up / complete all work” week.
Pick up breakfast and lunch for the week.
- Friday, May 29th 9:00-2:00: Last chance to return all work, all school materials,
library books, and laptops.
- Monday, June 1st Time TBA Collect personal belongings
Date may change this final week Possible desk clean out
Yearbook / report card distribution.
