	 Document daily participation for each student on each school day
	 Regularly communicate with parents and guardians regarding a pupil's academic progress
	 Provide regular feedback to students on progress related to distance learning activities
	 Provide daily designated and integrated English language development services to English learners
STUDENT RESPONSIBIITES	 Maintain a regular daily schedule, including healthy eating and sleeping habits
	 Come to distance learning time as you would class – washed up, dressed, and ready to learn
	Follow the distance learning class schedule
	Engage in distance learning activities
	Attend Office Hours or Intervention times as needed
	 Ask clarifying questions when you need help or don't understand
	Be respectful to yourself, teachers, and peers
	 Be respectful of any materials, supplies, or technology borrowed from the school
PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES	 Set up/designate a work area with the necessary school supplies
